





1. Am I keeping you well informed about state and local news in our district?




3. Do you believe that a driver's license, registration and insurance should be required of people who operate mopeds on public roadways?



2. Would you support a Right to Work law in Indiana, meaning that a worker cannot be required to join a labor union or pay labor union fees in order to get or keep a job?




4. Would you support a local option tax increase to fund mass transit, such as a commuter bus or light rail system?




5. Do you believe Indiana, like some other states, should implement random drug-testing as a requirement to receiving state-funded welfare benefits? Undecided



7. Would you support funding universities based on their graduation rate rather than enrollment?


